

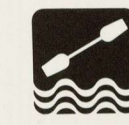


CANOE-KAYAK



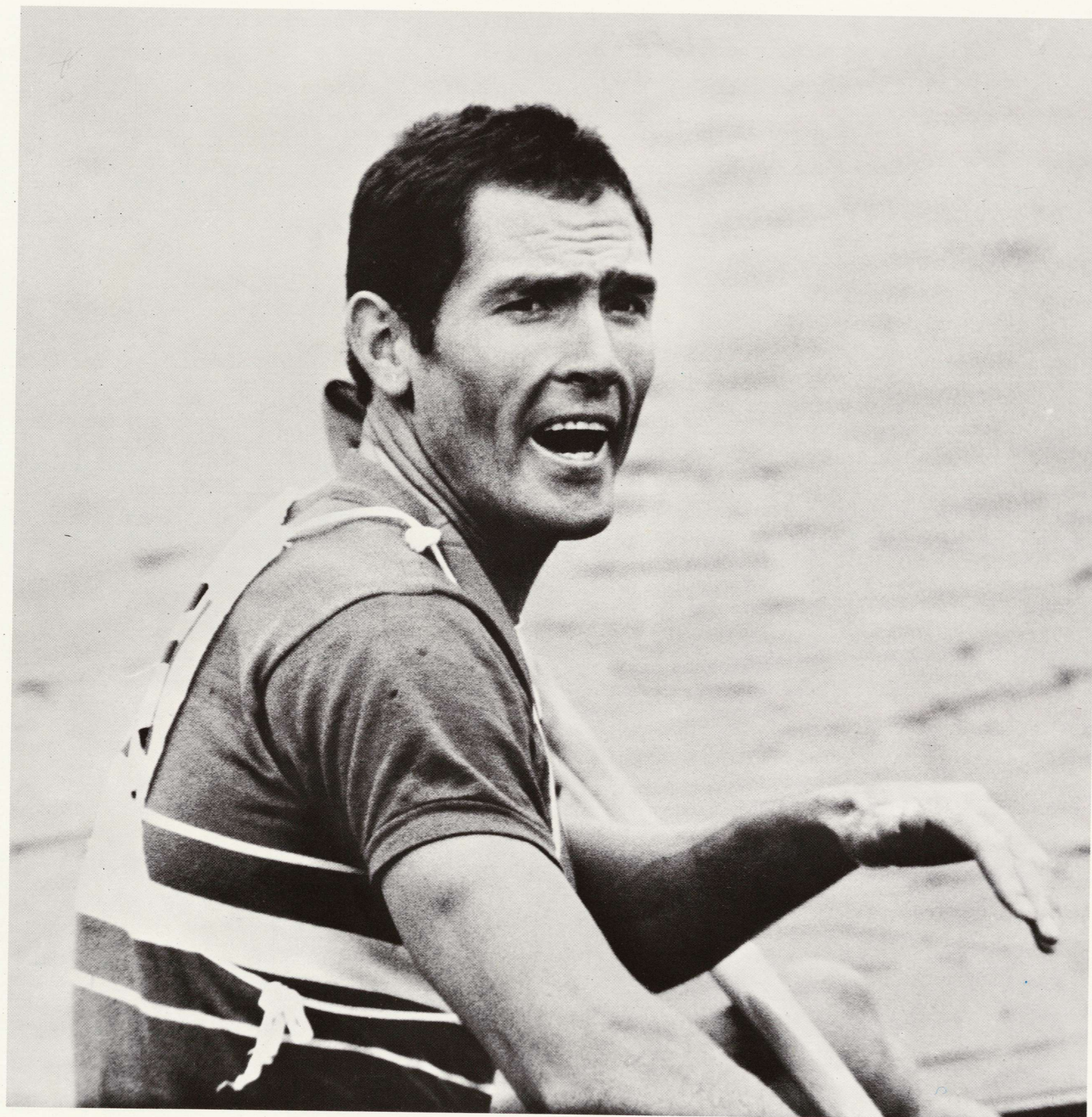
Cent quatre-vingt-trois athlètes provenant de vingt-sept pays — chiffre nettement supérieur à celui des Olympiades antérieures — ont pris part aux éliminatoires, repêchages et demi-finales des sept compétitions olympiques de canoë-kayak qui se sont déroulées, trois jours durant, sur le canal de Cuemanco. La présence de dix-huit champions olympiques et du monde (actuels ou anciens) parmi les participants explique l'intérêt suscité chez les supporters par le programme de 1968. On s'attendait une fois de plus à voir les Soviétiques, qui avaient remporté trois médailles d'or à Tokyo, se tailler la part du lion. A la hauteur de leur réputation, ils se distinguèrent en effet et enlevèrent des médailles dans six des sept catégories (deux d'or, une d'argent et trois de bronze). Pourtant les Hongrois, qui n'avaient remporté qu'une deuxième place à Tokyo, bouleversèrent tous les pronostics: battant les Soviétiques, ils gagnaient comme eux une médaille dans chacune des courses moins une, avec toutefois une meilleure distribution (deux d'or, trois d'argent et une de bronze). Les autres titres olympiques revinrent à l'Allemagne (qui remportait en outre deux médailles d'argent), à la Roumanie (qui gagnait aussi une médaille d'argent et une de bronze) et, à la surprise générale, en finale du K-4, à la Norvège.

CANOEING



More athletes took part in the four days of heats, repechages, semi-finals and finals in the canoeing competitions held at the impressive new Cuemanco Rowing and Canoeing Canal—the world's largest and most modern—than in any previous Olympic Games: 183 men and women from twenty-seven nations. The great interest aroused by the program among followers of the sport can be judged from the fact that eighteen current or former world champions and Olympic gold medalists were among the participants. The Soviet canoeing team, which won three Olympic championships in Tokyo, was again expected to take the lion's share of the awards. And in fact the Soviet paddlers turned in very impressive performances, winning medals in six of the regatta's seven events—two gold, one silver and three bronze. But another eastern European contingent, Hungary—which had managed no more than a single second-place finish in Tokyo—upset all predictions by outscoring the Soviets. They, too, took a medal in every race but one, but there was more glitter in the way their honors were distributed: two gold medals, three silver and one bronze. The other gold-medal winners were Germany (which in addition earned two silver medals), Rumania (which took a silver and a bronze as well), and—in a thrilling upset in the K-4 final—Norway.

Dans un sprint extraordinaire, Hesz (page de gauche), spécialiste des longues distances, remonte de la cinquième place qu'il occupait aux 500 mètres pour franchir la ligne le premier (ci-dessus), devant les favoris Hansen et Shaparenko. Les autres finalistes — dont le champion de Tokyo Peterson — saluent les vainqueurs de leurs pagaies durant la remise des prix.

With a formidable sprint, the long-distance specialist Hesz (opposite) moves from fifth place at 500 metres past pre-race favorites Hansen and Shaparenko to cross the finish line first (above). Raising their paddles in salute, the rest of the nine finalists—including Tokyo champion Peterson—render homage to the medal winners during the awards presentation.

Le gaucher Galkov (ci-dessus) réussit au finish à prendre quelques centimètres à Ctvrtecka et à mériter une place sur le podium (page de droite).

The overwhelming favorite, world-champion Lewe (left)—possibly handicapped by a brisk crosswind from his left which compelled him to steer with each stroke—was defeated in the final by the unheralded, left-paddling Tatai. Galkov (above), also a southpaw, forged past Ctvrtecka near the finish to take third by inches and win a place on the awards stand (opposite).

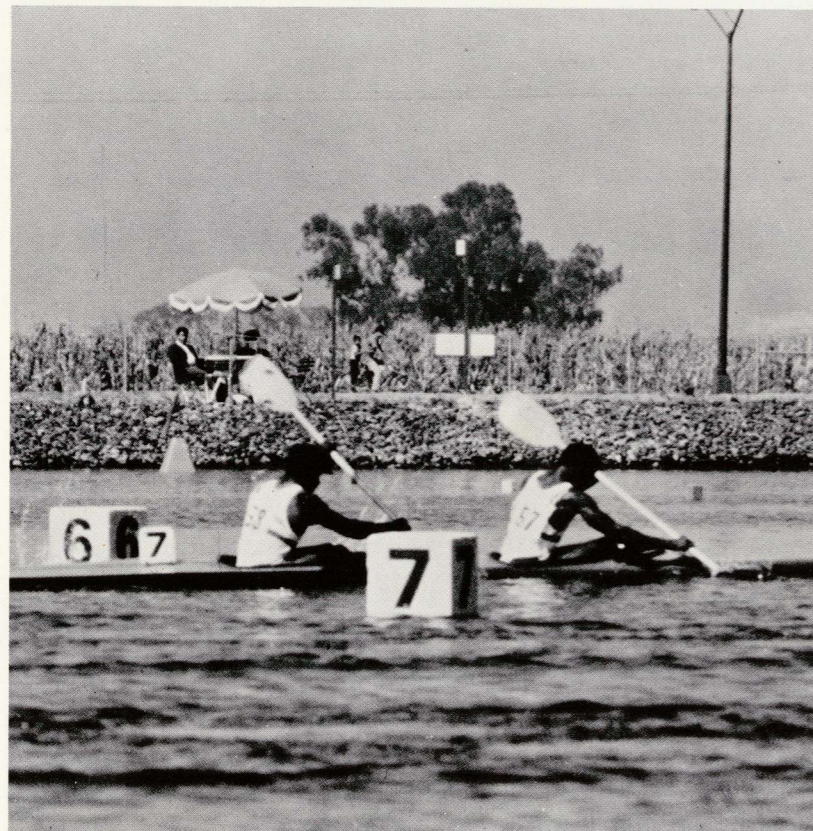

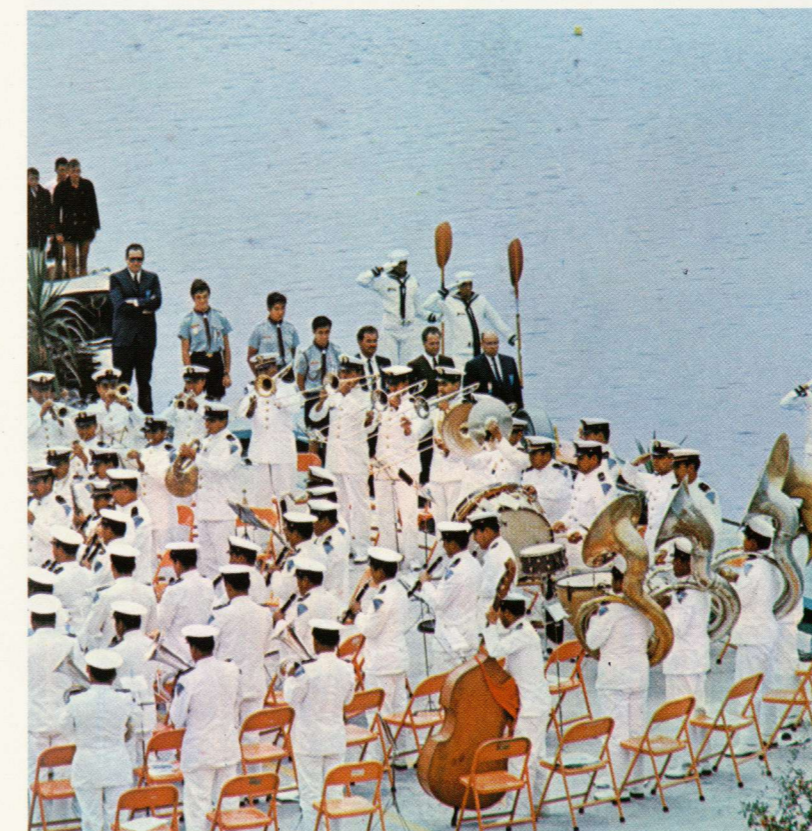

Relativement inexpérimenté, l'équipage norvégien de K-4 (page de gauche) n'avait jamais gagné de médaille olympique en canoë-kayak. Il n'en doubla pas moins la Hongrie et la Roumanie pour s'adjuger la victoire dans un style éblouissant. Ayant subi une avarie en demi-finale, les Soviétiques, partis favoris, ne réussirent pas à se qualifier pour la finale.

Norway's relatively inexperienced K-4 crew (opposite)—which had never won an Olympic canoeing medal—paddles in to the awards stand after electrifying the capacity crowd by forging past vaunted Hungary and Rumania to an astonishing upset victory. The favored Soviet boat failed to make the final as a result of a malfunctioning rudder in the semi-final.
