Report of TIP CSL camp Asian Olympic Qualification Miyi (China) - December 2011



A. Talent ID camp participants and management

1. Organisation

The camp was run from the 1st to 19th of December. The accommodation and feeding was in the national training centre facilities next by the Slalom venue.

- The group was made of 5 K1M, 1 K1W, 4 C1M and 1 C2M.
- 10 countries were present: HKG, KOR, LIB, MAS, SIN, THA, TPE, UZB, KAZ, IRI
- Average-age: 21

2. Coaching

2 coaches: Janos Peterlin (SLO) and Pierrick Gosselin (FRA) made a "flexible" program based on: fulls, halfs, technique and loops.

3. Remarks about the group

The global picture of the group is drastically different from 2008:

- Huge improvement from the paddlers followed for the last 2 years
- The ongoing selection for some athletes is a benefit for the camp
- The athletes are more autonomous regarding their training preparation

B. From 2008 to 2012

In 2008, Asian Olympic qualification (Nakkhon Nayok, THA), the development group was made of 10 paddlers from 4 different countries (India, Malaysia, Indonesia, Singapore). All K1 and one K1W. None of them could at that time get to semi-final.

In 2011, 12 paddlers (4 C1, 1 C2, 5 K1M and 1 K1W) from 10 different countries:

• Final: 2 C1M - 2 K1M

• Semi-final: 2 C1M - 1 C2M - 2 K1M

• Heats: 1 K1W - 1 K1M
