1. IMPORTANT: FEDERATIONS URGED TO ENSURE ATHLETES COMPLETE ANTI-DOPING COURSE

Unfortunately, at the recent World Cup we experienced that a number of athletes had not completed the anti-doping course, so once again we request National Federations, team leaders, coaches and athletes to pay attention to the fact that the International Canoe Federation congress has endorsed a proposal to extend compulsory anti-doping education courses to all senior, U23 and junior international athletes across all canoeing disciplines. This is a strong stand in the fight against doping.

It is important federations and teams understand that these education courses are compulsory for all international athletes and need to be completed before they compete in an international competition, including European Championships. **Athletes who have not completed the course will not be allowed to start.**

National federations have the possibility to check which athletes have already completed the course through the ICF database. Please follow the instruction in this <u>manual</u> available on the following page of the ICF website: https://www.canoeicf.com/anti-doping-education

3. Quota Per Nation

A nation (National Federation) can obtain 1 quota place per class.

4. Athlete Eligibility

All National Federations must participate in the applicable event at the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championships to be eligible for an Athlete Quota Place for that event in the Marathon Canoeing events at the World Games 2021.

5. **Qualification System**

Athlete quota places will be allocated to the respective National Federation's and not to Competitor(s) that achieved the place in the qualification event.

6. World Championships and Continental Qualification

- a. A National Federation will be able to obtain athlete quota places from the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championships. The best ranked boats in the Standard Distance Event will achieve quota places in that specific class for their National Federation.
- b. In the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championships the first placed boat from each continent will achieve quota places for their National Federation. (max. five places per class, K1 Men and K1 Women).
- c. The remaining quota places will be allocated to each NF of the best ranked boats until the required number of boat quota places have been achieved for the class concerned.
- d. Should a continent not be present in a particular event there will be no quota place allocated to that continent and the next best-ranked National Federation regardless of continent will be allocated the place from the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championship standings.
- e. If USA is represented in the continents that have achieved a quota place in an event at the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championships, then they will be the Continental allocation for America. In that event the host nation quota will be awarded to the next best ranked National Federation regardless of continent.

7. Confirmation process for quota places

The ICF will inform NFs in writing by 1 September 2020 of the athlete quota places they have obtained at the 2020 Marathon World Championships. Eligible NFs must inform the ICF in writing by 1 October 2020 whether or not they intend to participate at the World Games. By 1 November 2020 the ICF will reallocate all available quota places, as outlined below.

8. Reallocation of unused quota places

- a. Should a National Federation return or not use an athlete quota place from a continental allocation the next best ranked NF in that event from the same continent will be allocated the athlete quota place. The process will be repeated until all places are allocated.
- b. In the case where there are no more eligible National Federations that can gain an athlete quota place from the same continent, the athlete quota place will be given to the next best ranked NF from the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championships, not yet qualified in that event, regardless of continental representation.

- c. Should a National Federation return or not use an athlete quota place that has been obtained from the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championships, the next best ranked NF in that event, not yet qualified, will be allocated the athlete quota place. This process will be repeated until all places are allocated.
- d. If an athlete quota place is not filled from the procedures outlined above, the quota places will be allocated by the ICF on the principle of ranking of National Federations that are not qualified in any event at the World Games in Marathon.
- e. If the minimum quota places are not achieved by allocation one boat per nation a second place will be allocated from the best placed second boats from National Federations at the 2020 Canoe Marathon World Championships.



Important: We wish to remind you that we need 5 countries in a class to constitute a championships race. This is determined at the deadline for numerical entries. At the moment all classes but C1 Women short distance (so far only 4) have the required number of countries. The deadline therefore has been extended to 5th July.

Important information:

- The competition will be combined World and Asian Continental Championhips
- Participation-for-free-strategy: With the goal of encouraging more National Federations to participate in the competition the organizing committee is giving away one free place (paddler) from each national federation including meals, accommodation, local transportation and local boat rental and accreditation costs during competition, see event bulletin. Prize Money total €30.000 for seniors, under 23 and juniors.
- We wish to remind you that we need 6 countries in a class to constitute a championships race. This is determined at the deadline for numerical entries which is 2nd September.
- Masters World Championships will be held. Rules for these competitions are in the Masters bulletin which has been published on the ICF website and on facebook.

4. NEW NATION TALENT IDENTIFICATION PROGRAMME (TIP) 2019

NEW FOR CANOE MARATHON!!!

In the framework of the ICF Development Programme the so-called Talent Identification Programme will be organized for Canoe Marathon discipline for canoe and kayak paddlers in 2019.

The principal target of the TIP is to identify and promote talented athletes in canoe marathon who has potential for further improvement and who without the ICF and Chinese Canoe Association financial support wouldn't be able participate in the World Championships.

The programme will be held in connection with the Marathon World Championships in Shaoxing, China) 17th to 20th October 2019 and will include a training camp for approximately 1 week before the competition.

The project provides priority for the men and women kayakers and canoe paddlers from countries, which are new to Marathon or have not taken part in a Marathon World Championships before!

The Programme:

The invited athletes will participation in Training Camp and in the U23 or Senior World Championships in Shaoxing, China with a coaches' assistance. (Please note: Juniors will only be considered if they can be accompanied by another adult TIP applicant or an accompanying adult fully funded by the paddlers National Federation)

Application to the Programme:

Application can be sent by the national federations which have not entered the ICF Marathon World Championships before other than through a previous TIP programme.

• The age limit of the athletes is 15 to 23 of years. (Birth years are:1997-2004)

Application shall be sent with information on the proposed athletes to Tim Cornish at the e-mail address of cornishtj@qmail.com **before 26th July 2019**.

The camp will be limited to approximately 10 athletes so please apply early to be sure of being accepted.

Athletes might be invited continuously to the TIP in the coming years in consideration with their progress and cooperation with organization, coaches, team members and officials.

The applicant national federations will receive the decision of invitation to the programme before 2nd August 2019.

A final decision on holding the TIP will depend on receipt of sufficient applications of the type requested.

Financial conditions:

- Expenses (including accommodation, internal transport, boat rental and accreditation fee will be covered or arranged by the CCA Host Organization.
- The traveling to China and back to origin city including any visa costs must be paid by the participants National Federation.

RACES FOR THE WORLD SERIES AND THE WORLD RANKING SERIES:

The ICF Canoe Marathon World Ranking Series involves marathon races selected by the ICF Canoe Marathon Committee from major events around the world. These races, the World Cups and the World Championships form the World Ranking Series.

The Ranking starts with the first World Series Race held after the 2019 World Championships and ends with the following World Championships.

THE WORLD SERIES CLASSES

The World Series Raking classes are:

K1 Men

K1 Women

C1 Men

C1 Women

Invitations for these classes is mandatory. Other classes may be run by the organizer but are not part of the ICF World Ranking competition.

COMPETITORS

The World Series is open to all athletes who are members of clubs under a National Federation affiliated to the ICF. Individual race entries can be submitted directly to the race organizer according to the ICF rules, except for the World Cup and World Championships where entries must be made by National Federations.

RULES

The races must comply with the ICF regulations

MONEY PRIZES

To be part of the World Series must comply with the minimum prize money of 1.000Euros for each of the categories of the World Series

OBLIGATIONS FOR THE ORGANISERS:

Send the <u>results</u> within two days or sooner, if possible, in excel format

Promote the event. Local press, social media, website, etc.

Use the ICF Logo

Name the race as "...... World Series"

Short Summary video of the event

Live streaming if possible

ALLOCATION OF POINTS AND WORLD SERIES RANKING

Points towards the overall result will be awarded to the first 30 finishers in the four classes, according to the table below.

The allocation of points leads to the World Ranking with World Championships as the final event where the winners of each of the 4 classes will receive an ICF Trophy.

Where points in the series are equal, the paddler who has won the larger number of races will be the winner. In case that still being a tie, the most second places will be taken into account, and so on to third and fourth positions, until the position is determined.

In the event that all places are equal, the winner will be determined by position of the most recent races completed, i.e. last event has highest priority.
